NOTICE OF RACE

South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club invites club members & Bluewater Sailing employees & students to participate in this event, to be held Friday evenings, monthly April thru September. This event will have an inverted start (off Burton Chace Park), and sail up the channel, round the breakwater and return to start/finish line. The objective is to invite friends and members out for low key evening sail and return to the club afterwards. This is an Intraclub event.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. RULES

1.1 This series shall be governed by the 2021-2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The event is open to any PHRF boat between 18' to 38', non-spinnaker only.
- 2.2 Skippers shall be either a current SCCYC member, or Bluewater Sailing employee or student (within 2 years).

3. FEES Entry fee for each day of racing will be \$15, entire series \$40. Register by emailing event chair (required info: skipper, boat name, boat type, PHRF Non-Spin Area B), fees in will be collected in cash after your first race.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. April 19, May 31, June 21, July 19, Aug 30, Sep 27.
- 4.2. Starting sequence shall commence at 17:45.
- 4.3. There will be no committee boat on station so boats will self-start and finish.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions are attached to the end of this document.
- **6. VENUE** The race area will be mostly inside of the Marina.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. First boat home wins.
- 7.2. A finish report must be made by either the skipper or crew member in person, on a white board at the club prior to 19:45 to be scored (no phoning in or delegation to non-crew)
- 7.3. A high point system (one throw-out) will be used and a trophy will be presented after the final race.
- 7.4. Handicap will be based on the PHRF Area B WL with nonspin offset. Email Race Chair within 24 hrs of race to confirm handicap, if your boat is not rated with PHRF the Race chair will issue a provisional handicap.

8. PRIZES/HOSPITALITY

Result announcements will be held circa 20:00 hrs and bottle of wine will be presented to the wine. Participants are invited to tie up in the vicinity of the club and join in a BBQ at the club, or bring your own dinner.



Friday Twilight Posse - SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

CHECK IN:

Boats intending to race shall contact the race control vessel on VHF Channel 71. Check-in will commence at 15:45 and cease at 15:55. Failure to check-in may be grounds for DNS.

ORDER OF START:

Boats are bracketed into 15 second per mile increments and backets are set to start on the whole minute. Use PDT atomic clock UTC. Boats are considered racing 5 minutes prior to their allotted start and should cease motoring.

START & FINISH LINE:

This will be an imaginary line from the first White Speed Channel buoy to the first Piling at the four - hour transient guest dock. This is a straight line from the White Speed Channel Buoy and the Piling. Start with the White Speed Channel Buoy on your Starboard side. Finish with the White Speed Channel Buoy to your Port Side.

COURSES:


COURSE 1: From the starting line proceed down the channel towards the detached break wall staying within the **NO SAIL** buoys. Round the breakwater in either direction and retrace a reverse course back to the finish off Burton Chase Park.

COURSE 2: From the starting line proceed down the channel towards the detached break wall staying within the **NO SAIL** buoys rounding the last **NO SAIL** buoy on the south side of the channel to port and return to the finish line at Burton Chase Park.

The default course is course 1. The shorter Course 2 may be selected prior to the start, or by hailing the fleet on Channel 71 prior to first boat reaching the turning mark. There will be no time adjustments for starts or finishes if Course 2 is selected.

FINISH:

All participants are responsible for recording their finish time and taking note of the boat immediately ahead and behind them. This finish report shall be transposed by a member of the crew on a white board for this purpose at SCCYC. Boats failing to record their finish time by 19:45 shall be considered DNF.
