



Notice of Race
One Design Weekend July 20 and 21, 2013
Marina del Rey, CA

Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

Eligibility: All One Design Boats, limited to 5 classes. This may be modified at the discretion of the Race Committee. Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, and a member of the fleet in which it competes.

Classes: We expect Lido 14, OPEN 5.70, C15s. We would very much like to have a Viper 640 class. We invite one more class to join us. Any One Design Class is encouraged to have a representative contact Jr Staff Commodore, Bruce Fleck at 310-600-5214.

Entries: Entries must be received by 9 AM, on Saturday, the day of the race.
 The Entry Fees are as follows.

Boats 20 feet or under	\$35
Boats over 20 feet and less than 31	\$45
Boats over 31 feet	\$75

Race entries may be completed on line at SCCYC.org or deposited in the race entry box (mail box) on the southwest wall near the bottom of the stairs or mailed to the SCCYC Clubhouse at 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC no later than 2000 hours on the Thursday, prior to the race.

RETIRE BEFORE FINISHING

If for any reason a boat lags behind to the extent that they will be delaying the start of the next race for their class they may RBF (Retire Before Finishing). Boats may notify the RC after starting and before finishing that they wish to retire from the race and accept a last place finish. If more than one boat elects to RBF, points equal to last, second to last and so on will be awarded to such boats evenly. This does not override any action taken by a Protest Committee. This changes RRS 28 and A4.1.

Starting Time & Expected Finish Time: For all classes on Saturday and Sunday the first warning for the first class will be at 12:55. Saturday the RC will attempt to finish racing at 6 PM, Sunday the RC will attempt to finish racing at 5 PM.

Courses: Courses will be primarily windward/leeward using orange and yellow inflatable marks. The course will be North of the Marina Del Rey Spar buoys. 3 or 4 races for all classes on Saturday and 2 or 3 races for all classes on Sunday. Different classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as the weather allows.

1DW Series Scoring: Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, with one throw out, if 6 or more races are completed.

Penalties: Rule 44 is changed so that if an incident occurs outside the three-boat-length zone for a rounding or finishing mark, then the penalty under rule 44.2 shall be one turn including one tack and one gibe.

1DW Trophies: Trophies for the Series will be awarded at SCCYC following the last race on Saturday, July 25th

Hospitality: Complimentary informal dinner for all racers as well as a no-host bar will be available at the SCCYC Club House following the racing.
