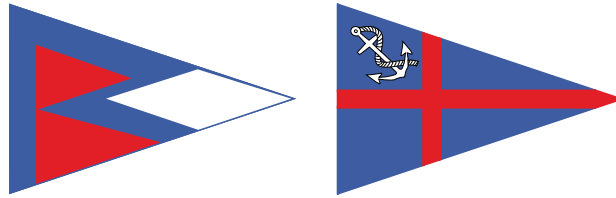


Sailing Instructions

2011 Corinthian Cup

1. **RULES:** This series will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:** Notices to Competitors will be posted at the clubs no later than 0900 hours each day or given by the Race Committee on station for each race.
3. **SCHEDULE:** One race is planned for Saturday, and one is planned for Sunday. The warning signal for Saturday shall be at 12:55 hours, the warning signal for Sunday shall be 11:55 hours.
4. **CLASSES:** There will be three classes: Cruisers under 30 feet, Cruisers 30 feet and over, and PHRF (all ratings). Cruisers without a PHRF rating will be assigned one by the race committee. The Race Committee reserves the option to assign entries to classes for competitive balance.
5. **COMMUNICATIONS:** The RC will monitor channel 68
6. **PROTESTS:** Protests must be filed in writing (forms available) at destination Club within 90 minutes after the protesting boat finishes.
7. **SCORING SYSTEM:** The corrected finish times for each leg will be added for each boat to determine the class position. In the event a boat does not finish one leg for any reason she will be assigned a finish time for that leg calculated by the Race Committee.
8. **CHECK IN:** Contestants are requested to check in prior to the first warning signal each day, and to notify the Race Committee if they leave the course during racing.
9. **PRIZES:** Trophies will be awarded at the SCCYC Clubhouse after racing is completed on Sunday. A name plate for the winner of each class will be added to the perpetual trophy.

Dock space is usunot assigned until the day before and sometimes not until you arrive in Redondo Beach. Boats assigned a slip will exchange \$20 for a dock/head key on arrival. The key may be returned (exchanged for \$20) once the skipper who borrowed the key is identified, either to the KHM desk, to RBYC V/C Carlos Perez or to RBYC Race/C John Ellinwood. Either Patrick or John will be available at SCCYC Sunday between 1800 and the trophy presentation, and Sun AM at RBYC between 0900 and 1000.

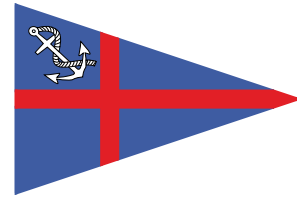
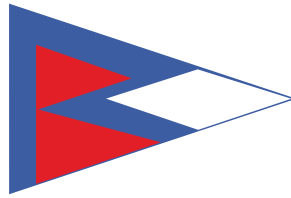

12. **THE START:** Races will be started in accordance with Rule 26 except that the start signal for class one will be the warning signal for class 2. All classes will start between the starting mark and an orange flag on the Race Committee boat. Class Flags:

Code Flag 1 - PHRF **and** 30+

Code Flag 2 - under 30.

13. **COURSES:** *Please note!* The courses are different from previous years.

Saturday From the starting line, in the vicinity of MDR “SS” Mark, proceed to marks as follows, leaving all marks to port, and finishing inside King Harbor per **FINISH instructions:**

Cruiser Under 30 Feet9.9 nm

MdR “SS” • MdR “S” • “2ES” • KH “C” • KH “K” • KH “G” • KH “W” Finish

Cruiser 30 Feet and Over. 12.1 nm

MdR “SS” • MdR “D” • KH “F” • KH “K” • KH “G” • KH “W” Finish

PHRF. 12.9 nm

MdR “SS” • MdR “T” • KH “F” • KH “K” • KH “G” • KH “W” Finish

FINISH instructions:

“K” is a spar buoy at N33-50-03.4, W118-24-42.9

“G” is the red and white bell buoy 0.15 nm outside the harbor entrance

“W” is the white 5-MPH can buoy in the harbor entrance

finish near the entrance between the RC anchored behind the breakwater and the red beacon on the East entrance breakwater.

Sunday From the starting line, in the vicinity of KH “Y” Mark, proceed to marks as follows, leaving all marks to starboard, and finishing inside MdR south entrance per **FINISH instructions:**

Cruiser Under 30 Feet9.6 nm

KH “Y” • KH “K” • “2ES” • MdR “S” • Rocks • Ballona

Cruiser 30 Feet and Over. 11.1 nm

KH “Y” • KH “B” • MdR “D” • Rocks • Ballona

PHRF. 12.7 nm

KH “Y” • KH “J” • MdR “T” • Rocks • Ballona

FINISH instructions:

The finish line is between the light on the detached breakwater at the South Entrance to Marina del Rey and an orange flag on the committee boat anchored in the mouth of Ballona Creek.

14. **MARKS:** MDR mark locations are found on **MDR_CourseChart16.pdf**. Redondo Beach marks *have changed* and are posted to the scyc.org website as **2013-KingHarbor-Racing-Marks.pdf**. Copies of both charts should be available at the clubs.

15. **TIME LIMIT:** The time limit for each leg is four hours. If one boat in a class finishes within the time limit other boats in that class may finish up to five hours after the start. If no boats in a class finish by within 4 hours the leg will be abandoned for that class.
