

Notice of Race

Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2005-2008, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the PHRF and/or one-design class rules, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any Amendments and Notices issued by the Race Committee.

Classes: Possible classes are PHRF A and B, Schock 35, Martin 242, J24, J80, Star, Santana 20, Cal 20. A minimum of three boats will establish a class. Five boats in a class will get a separate start. One Design Classes must have a representative contact Race Chairman, Stu Coleman at (310)821-6407 or Principal Race Officer Bob Kellock at (562)982-7779 day or (562)424-9520 evenings by Wednesday, March 22nd, at 7:00 PM to be recognized as a class.

Eligibility: Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA and US Sailing, and racing a boat that is registered in the class or fleet in which it competes.

Entries: Entries should be received by Saturday, March 26, 006, at 9:00 AM. The entry fee is \$20 (\$5 less if a member of US Sailing). Checks should be made payable to SCCYC. Race entries may be deposited in the race entry box (mail box) on the southwest wall near the bottom of the stairs to the SCCYC Clubhouse at 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC no later than 2000 hours on Friday, March 24.

Starting Time & Location: The first race will start at 1200 hours each day, with the Warning Signal at 1155 hours in the vicinity of "S" mark.

Courses: Courses will be chosen from Marina del Rey Course Chart #16 and/or possible courses identified in the Sailing Instructions, and will be sailed on the Marina del Rey buoys outside the MDR Breakwater. Different classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as the weather allows.

Series Scoring: Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, with no throw outs, will be used.

Trophies: Trophies for the Series will be awarded at SCCYC following the last race on Sunday, March 26.

Hospitality: Burgers and Hot Dogs as well as a no-host bar will be at the SCCYC Club House following both days of racing.
