 Honoring Les Storrs, SCCYC Commodore, 1936
Saturday, March 22, 2008
Marina del Rey, California



Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing. The PHRF Marine Professional rule does not apply.

Eligibility: All keelboats. Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, and a member of the class or fleet in which it competes. Entrants in the PHRF classes Must have a 2007 or 2008 PHRF certificate.

Classes: Possible classes are PHRF A and B, Schock 35, Martin 242, J24, J80, Holder 20, Star, Open 5.70, Santana 20, Cal 20. Classes will be established based upon the number of paid entrants as of 8 pm on March 19th. A minimum of three boats will establish a class. Five boats in a class will get a separate start. One Design Classes are encouraged to have a representative contact Race Chairman, Bruce Fleck at (310) 869-9187.

Entries: Entries should be received by Saturday, March 22, 2008, at 9:00 AM. The entry fee is \$25 (\$20 if a member of US Sailing). Checks should be made payable to SCCYC. Race entries may be deposited in the race entry box (mail box) on the southwest wall near the bottom of the stairs to the SCCYC Clubhouse at 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC no later than 2000 hours on Friday, March 21

Starting Time & Location: The first race will start at 1200 hours, with the Warning Signal at 1155 hours in the vicinity of "S" mark.

Courses: Courses will be chosen from MdR Course Chart #16 and/or possible courses identified in the Sailing Instructions, and will be sailed on the buoys outside the MdR Breakwater. Classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as the weather allows.

Series Scoring: Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, with no throw outs, will be used.

Penalties: Rule 44 is changed so that if an incident occurs outside the two-boat-length zone for a rounding or finishing mark, the penalty under rule 44.2 shall be one turn including one tack and one gybe.

Trophies: Trophies for the Series will be awarded at SCCYC following the last race on Saturday, March 22.

Hospitality: Complimentary Burgers and Hot Dogs for Racers and Crew as well as a no-host bar will be at the SCCYC Club House following the day of racing.
