

Notice of Race

2008 One Design Weekend Saturday, July 19, and Sunday, July 20 Marina del Rey, California



Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2005-2008, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the one-design class rules, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any Amendments and Notices issued by the Race Committee.

Classes: A minimum of three boats will establish a class. Five boats in a class will get a separate start.

Eligibility: Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, and racing a boat that is registered in the class in which it competes.

Entries: Entries to establish a class and starts should be received by Friday, July 18, 2008, at 2000 hours. All entries should be received by Saturday, July 19, 2008, at 0900 hours.

Fees: The entry fee for boats 34 Feet or longer is \$50 and for boats less than 34 Feet is \$40. (\$5 less if a member of US Sailing). Checks should be payable to SCCYC. Race entries may be deposited in the race entry box (mail box) on the southwest wall near the bottom of the stairs to the SCCYC Clubhouse at 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC no later than 0930 hours on Saturday, July 19.

Starting Time & Location: The first race will start at 1200 hours each day, with the Warning Signal at 1155 hours in a racing area North of "S" mark.

Courses: Courses will be primarily windward/leeward using orange and yellow inflatable marks. The course will be North of the Marina Del Rey Spar buoys. 3 races on Saturday and 2 races on Sunday are planned. Different classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as the weather allows.

I-Design Weekend Series Scoring: Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, with no throw outs, will be used.

Trophies: 48 Commemorative Pint Glass Trophies for the I-Design Weekend Series will be awarded at SCCYC following the last race on Sunday, July 20.

Docking: Docking will not be available at SCCYC to allow for trailerable boats to be hoisted in and out.
