

Notice of Race

2008 Outlook Trophy Race

Sunday, August 24th, 2008

Marina del Rey, California



Rules: This race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2005-2008, the prescriptions of US Sailing, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any Amendments and Notices issued by the Race Committee. RRS 44.2 (the 720 penalty rule) will be in effect. RRS 40 will be changed to apply for all classes regardless of whether code flag "Y" is displayed.

Classes: Classes are centerboards (20 feet and under) and catamarans (20 feet and under). Three or more one-design boats will establish a one-design class. One Design Classes must have a representative contact Race Chair/Principal Race Officer Stu Coleman at 323-314-2963 by Wednesday, August 20th, at 7:00 PM to be recognized as a class.

Eligibility: Eligible yachts are classified by Portsmouth as centerboards or catamarans, 20 feet or less LOA, rated (D-PN) 110 or less. We also welcome the Holder 20 and any other small keelboat class to compete as a fleet

Entries: Entries must be received by Sunday, August 24, 2008, at 0900 hours. Competitors who have not reached their eighteenth (18th) birthday must also have their entry forms signed by a parent or guardian.

Fees: The entry fee is \$15 (\$5 less if a member of US Sailing) or free to Junior Members of Yacht Clubs. Checks should be payable to SCCYC. Race entries may be deposited in the race entry box (mail box) on the southwest wall near the bottom of the stairs to the SCCYC Clubhouse at 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be posted on the SCCYC web site (www.sccyc.org) no later than Thursday, August 21, 2007 and will be available at SCCYC no later than 0900 hours on Sunday, August 26, 2007.

Skippers meeting: A mandatory skippers' meeting will be held at SCCYC at 0930 hours the day of the race. Time allowances/starting times will be assigned at the skippers' meeting.

Starting Time & Location: The race will start at 1200 hours, with the Warning Signal at 1155 hours in the vicinity of "S" mark. This is an "inverted start" race; time allowances are given at the start. Yachts with greater allowances start before yachts with lesser allowances.

Course: The course will be published in the sailing instructions and will use the race marks in the Marina del Rey Olympic circle. The course will be approximately 12.8 miles.

Trophies: Trophies for the Race will be awarded at SCCYC following the race.
