
## **Sailing Instructions**

## 2010 Corinthian Cup

Saturday, May 29 Sunday, May 30 Marina del Rey, California



- 2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS: Notices to Competitors will be posted at the clubs no later than 0900 hours each day or given by the Race Committee on station for each race.
- **3. SCHEDULE:** One race is planned for Saturday, and one is planned for Sunday. The warning signal for the race each day shall be at 12 55 hours.
- 4. CLASSES: There will be three classes: Cruisers under 30 feet, Cruisers 30 feet and over, and PHRF (all ratings). Cruisers without a PHRF rating will be assigned one by the race committee. The Race Committee reserves the option to assign entries to classes for competitive balance.
- **5. THE START:** Races will be started in accordance with Rule 26. All classes will start between the starting mark and an orange flag on the Race Committee boat.

#### **Class flags:**

Code Flag 1 - PHRF and 30+ Code Flag 2 - under 30. Sunday KH "S" mark Vicinity 1200 hours:PHRF and 30' + over 1205 hours: under 30'

### 6. COURSES:

Saturday From MdR "H" mark, the starting line, proceed to marks as follows, leaving all marks to **port**, and finishing inside King Harbor per FINISH instructions:

- El Segundo Bell Buoy "2ES"
- KH "C"
- KH "X"
- Finish inside

### Cruiser 30 Feet and Over. . . . . . . . . 12 nm

- KH "X"

## THE FINISH:

**Saturday:** The finish line is between the light on the inner breakwater and an orange flag on the Race Committee boat anchored inside the outer breakwater.

ALL RACING YACHTS ARE TO LEAVE THE WHITE AND ORANGE BUOY MARKING THE CENTER OF THE KING HARBOR ENTRANCE CHANNELTO PORT when entering King Harbor.

Sunday: The finish line is between the light on the detached breakwater at the South Entrance to Marina del Rey and an orange flag on the committee boat anchored in the mouth of Ballona Creek.

7. The RC will monitor channel 68

- **8. TIME LIMIT:** Each race leg will be abandoned after 1800 hours. Boats finishing after 1800 will be scored DNF. This changes Rule 35.
- **9. PROTESTS:** Protests must be filed in writing (forms available) at destination Club within 90 minutes of the finish time of the last yacht to finish.
- **10. SCORING SYSTEM:** The corrected finish times for each race will be added for each boat to determine the class position.

- 11. CHECK IN: Contestants are requested to check in prior to the first warning signal each day, and to notify the Race Committee if they leave the course during racing.
- **13. PRIZES:** Trophies will be awarded at the SCCYC Clubhouse after racing is completed on Sunday.

A name plate for the winner of each class will be added to the perpetual trophy.
