

Notice of Race
2010 Outlook Trophy Race
Sunday August 22rd, 2010
Marina del Rey, California



Rules: This race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Racing. Rule 44.2 is modified to require all competitors to wear personal flotation at all times except for short periods while changing clothes.

Classes: The race is open to all centerboards boats of 20 feet or less with Portsmouth DPN of 110 or less, and catamarans of 20 feet or less with Portsmouth DPN of 110 or less. Three or more one design boats will establish a one design class. One design classes must notify the Race Chair John Richardson, by Wednesday, August 18th at 7 PM to be recognized as a class. At the discretion of the RC, other boats may be invited to race. These invited boats are not eligible to win the Outlook Trophy.

Entries: Entries must be received by 0900 hours on the day of the event. Competitors that have not reached their eighteenth birthday must have their entry forms signed by their parent or guardian.

Fees: The entry fee is \$20, \$5 less if a member of US Sailing, the entry is free to junior members of any yacht club. Entries may be done on line at SCCYC.org or the form below may be submitted.

Checks should be made payable to SCCYC. Race entries may be deposited in the race entry box on the south west wall at the bottom of the stairs to the SCCYC club house at 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be posted at www.SCCYC.org no later than the Thursday before the race. SIs will also be available at the skippers meeting at 0900 the day of the race.

Skippers Meeting: Skippers meeting will be held at SCCYC at 0930 the day of the race. Starting times will be assigned at the skippers meeting.

Starting Time and Location: The race will start at noon with a warning signal at 1155 in the vicinity of SS mark. This is an inverted start race; time allowances are given at the beginning of the race.

Course: The course will be included in the sailing instructions and will use the racing marks as defined in Marina del Rey Course Chart 16. The course will be approximately 12.8 miles.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded at SCCYC following the race.
