



Notice of Race/Sailing Instructions

2010 Campbell Cup

Cruise and Race

Saturday, October 23, 2010

Rules: This race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Racing.

Eligibility: Entrant must be a member in good standing of South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club..

Classes: There will be one class. For boats electing to race non spin the Off-Wind PHRF rating will be used. Boats without a PHRF certificate will be assigned a rating by the RC. Dinghys are welcome to race.

Entries: Entry forms and cruiser off set forms, attended by a fee of \$10 must be received by 1030 hours on Saturday. Entry forms will be available at the club prior to the skipper's meeting.

Mandatory Skippers Meeting: Important information will be disseminated at the 1030 hours meeting.

Starting: The race will start at 1155 hours.

Course: Start will be between SS mark and the flag on the break water. Round Santa Monica Bell Buoy, leaving it to starboard. Enter the marina through the north entrance, similar to the course sailed by Phil Campbell (Security will not chase you out of the area, as they did Phil). Spinnakers must be dropped before entering the main channel and cannot be used in the channel.

Finish: The finish will be between an orange inflatable in the channel and a orange flag at Burton Chase Park.

Time Limit: to qualify for a trophy the boat must finish before 1600 on Saturday the 24th.

Protests: There should be no protests of any significance.

Scoring: PHRF corrected time will be use to determine the winner.

Communications: the RC will monitor VHF channel 71.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded after the race at SCCYC. The first place finisher will be added to the perpetual and awarded a "Phil Campbell" cup.

Hospitality: Burgers and dogs at the club after the race.
