

Notice of Race
One Design Weekend
July 23 and 24
Marina del Rey, CA



Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

Eligibility: All One Design Boats, limited to 5 classes. This may be modified at the discretion of the Race Committee. Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, and a member of the fleet in which it competes.

Classes: Schock 35, Martin 242, OPEN 5.70,. We invite two more classes to join us. Any One Design Class is encouraged to have a representative contact Jr Staff Commodore, Bruce Fleck at 310-869-9187 or JrStaffCommodore@sccyc.org

Entries: Entries must be received by 9 AM, on Saturday, the day of the race.
The Entry Fees are as follows.

Boats 20 feet or under	\$25
Boats over 20 feet and less than 31	\$35
Boats over 31 feet	\$75

Race entries may be completed on line at SCCYC.org or deposited in the race entry box (mail box) on the southwest wall near the bottom of the stairs or mailed to the SCCYC Clubhouse at 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

Sailing Instructions: will be available at SCCYC no later than 2000 hours on the Thursday, prior to the race.

Starting Time & Expected Finish Time: For all classes on Saturday and Sunday the first warning for the first class will be at 12:55. Saturday the RC will attempt to run four races, finish racing at 6 PM, Sunday the RC will attempt to run three races finishing at 5 PM. Classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as the weather allows.

Courses: Courses will be primarily windward/leeward using orange and yellow inflatable marks. When possible the course will include a gate. The course will be North of the Marina Del Rey Spar buoys.

Penalties: Rule 44 is changed so that if an incident occurs outside the three-boat-length zone for a rounding or finishing mark, then the penalty under rule 44.2 shall be one turn including one tack and one gibe.

Scoring: If 6 or more races are completed there will be one throw out.

Launching: Use of the hoist is limited to boats of 2000 lbs or less. A club member will be available to operate the hoist.

Parking: Passes are available for the two days of the event.

OD Trophies: Trophies for the Series will be awarded at SCCYC following the last race on Saturday, July 25th

Hospitality: The 79 year long tradition at South Coast Corinthian is “racers eat for free”.
