1. RULES:

This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:

Any Notices will be posted on the outdoor bulletin board on the southwest wall of the SCCYC Clubhouse not later than 0930 hours on the day of the race.

3. CHANGES TO THE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the outdoor bulletin board on the southwest wall of the SCCYC Clubhouse not later than 0930 hours on the day of the race.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES:

5.1 For all classes on Saturday the first warning for the first class will be at 11:55. The RC will attempt to finish racing at 1600.

5.2 Contestants are requested to check in prior to the first warning signal, and to notify the Race Committee if they leave the course during racing.

5.3 The RC will attempt to run 3 races for all classes.

5.4 Different classes may sail a different number of races.

6. CLASS FLAGS:

6.1 The order of starts and class flags for the first race on Saturday and Sunday will be posted at SCCYC.

6.2 One Design classes are welcome to petition the RC to use their class flag.

7. RACING AREA:

The racing area is outside the Marina del Ray breakwater, the area covered by Course Chart 16.



8. COURSES and Marks:

Courses will be selected from and marks are described in Course Chart 16. If a mark is missing it will be replaced by yellow inflatable. Courses will be indicated by code flags. If D Mark is the weather mark, U mark is a yellow spar not an inflatable.

9. STARTS:

A rolling five minute sequence will be used. The start signal for the first class will be the warning signal for the next class. The class and course will be signaled after the warning signal and before the preparatory signal for each class. This changes RRS 27.1

10. Start and Finish Line.

The start line will be between an orange flag on the committee boat and an inflatable to the committee boat's left. The finish line will be between a blue flag on the committee boat and an orange flag in the water to the committee boat's right.

12. CHANGING THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE:

Course changes will be signaled by displaying the code flag for the new weather mark.

13. PENALITIES:

Rule 44.2 is changed: If an incident occurs outside the zone of a rounding or finishing mark, rule 44.2 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

14. TIME LIMIT AND TARGET TIMES.

There are no time limits nor target times.

15. PROTESTS:

Protesting boats are asked to notify the Race Committee at the finish line of their intent to protest. Protests must be filed at SCCYC within one hour of the Race Committee's return to the Clubhouse.

16. SCORING:

A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

17. RADIO COMMUNICATION:

The Race Committee will monitor channel 68.

18. HOSPITALITY / PRIZES:

SCCYC will have food free to all racers. No host donation bar..
