1. **RULES:** This series will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:** Notices to Competitors will be posted at the clubs no later than 0900 hours each day or given by the Race Committee on station for each race.
3. **SCHEDULE:** One race is planned for Saturday, and one is planned for Sunday. The warning signal for Saturday shall be at 12:55 hours, the warning signal for Sunday shall be 11:55 hours.
4. **CLASSES:** There will be three classes: Cruisers under 30 feet, Cruisers 30 feet and over, and PHRF (all ratings). Cruisers without a PHRF rating will be assigned one by the race committee. The Race Committee reserves the option to assign entries to classes for competitive balance.
5. **COMMUNICATIOBNS:** The RC will monitor channel 68
6. **PROTESTS:** Protests must be filed in writing (forms available) at destination Club within 90 minutes after the protesting boat finishes.
7. **SCORING SYSTEM:** The corrected finish times for each leg will be added for each boat to determine the class position. In the event a boat does not finish one leg for any reason she will be assigned a finish time for that leg calculated by the Race Committee.
8. **CHECK IN:** Contestants are requested to check in prior to the first warning signal each day, and to notify the Race Committee if they leave the course during racing.
9. **PRIZES:** Trophies will be awarded at the SCCYC Clubhouse after racing is completed on Sunday. A name plate for the winner of each class will be added to the perpetual trophy.

Either Patrick or John will be available at SCCYC Sunday between 1800 and the trophy presentation, and Sun AM at RBYC between 0900 and 1000.

12. **THE START:** Races will be started in accordance with Rule 26 except that the start signal for class one will be the warning signal for class 2. All classes will start between the starting mark and an orange flag on the Race Committee boat. Class Flags:

Code Flag 1 - PHRF **and** 30+

Code Flag 2 - under 30.

13. COURSES:

Saturday From MdR “H” mark, the starting line, proceed to marks as follows, leaving all marks to port, and finishing inside King Harbor per FINISH instructions:

Cruiser Under 30 Feet 10 nm

• MdR “S” • El Segundo Bell Buoy “2ES” • KH “C” • KH “X” • Finish inside

Cruiser 30 Feet and Over. 12 nm

• MdR “D” • El Segundo Bell Buoy “2ES” • KH “F” • KH “X” • Finish inside

PHRF. 13 nm

• MdR “T” • El Segundo Bell Buoy “2ES” • KH “F” • KH “X” Finish inside

LEAVE THE WHITE AND ORANGE BUOY MARKING THE CENTER OF THE KING HARBOR ENTRANCE CHANNEL TO PORT when entering King Harbor. The finish line is between the light on the inner breakwater and an orange flag on the Race Committee boat anchored inside the outer breakwater.

Sunday From the starting line, at KH “S” mark proceed to marks as follows, leaving all marks to starboard, and finishing inside MdR south entrance per FINISH instructions:

Cruiser Under 30 Feet 10 nm

• KH “A” • El Segundo Bell Buoy “2ES” • MdR “S” • Finish inside

Cruiser 30 Feet and Over. 12 nm

• KH “F” • El Segundo Bell Buoy “2ES” • MdR “D” • Finish inside

PHRF. 13 nm

• KH “F” • El Segundo Bell Buoy “2ES” • MdR “T” • Finish inside

The finish line is between the light on the detached breakwater at the South Entrance to Marina del Rey and an orange flag on the committee boat anchored in the mouth of Ballona Creek.

14. **MARKS:** Marina del Rey mark locations are found on Course Chart 16. Redondo Beach mark locations are found on mark_guide_2011_rev_03-17-11.pdf. Copies of both charts will be available at both clubs.

15. **TIME LIMIT:** The time limit for each leg is four hours. If one boat in a class finishes within the time limit other boats in that class may finish up to five hours after the start. If no boats in a class finish by within 4 hours the leg will be abandoned for that class.
