Marina del Rey & King Harbor, CA

Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Any sailing Instructions on the mark charts DO NOT APPLY, and only the Corinthian Cup Sailing Instructions apply.

Classes: There will be three classes: Cruisers 30 feet and under, Cruisers over 30 feet, and PHRF (all ratings).

Cruisers without a PHRF rating must fill out the ASMBYC Cruiser class adjustment form to be assigned a rating by the race committee. Cruisers choosing NOT to use a spinnaker will be given a spinnaker offset of 18 seconds per mile (+18), unless their PHRF certificate indicates otherwise. The ASMBYC cruiser class adjustment form can be found at http://www.sccyc.org and emailed to racechair@sccyc.org or faxed to 805-299-4512.

Eligibility: Club and PHRF memberships are urged but not required. A current PHRF certificate is required for PHRF classes but, not required for entrants in the Cruising classes. The Race Committee reserves the option to assign entries to classes for competitive balance.

Entries: Entries should preferably be filled out using the online form and will be accepted no later than 20:00hrs on Friday prior to the race. Late entries must be in writing and no later than **9:00 AM on the day of the race**. The entry fee is **\$35** for the two-day, two-leg series, or \$20 for one leg (\$5 less if a member of US Sailing).

Until Friday May25th 2000hrs, use the online entry form: http://www.sccyc.org/online_entry.html. When paying by check, make it payable to SCCYC. Race entries can also be deposited in the race entry box (by the stairs to the SCCYC Clubhouse) or mailed to SCCYC at 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC, RBYC and on the SCCYC web site (www.sccyc.org) no later than **2000 hours** on **Friday, the day prior to the race**.

Starting Time & Location: The race will start at 1300 hours each day, with the Warning Signal at 1255 hours. On Saturday, the start will be at MdR 'H" mark. On Sunday, the start will be at KH "S" mark.

Courses: On Saturday, the courses will be from Marina del Rey to King Harbor, using existing marks in Santa Monica Bay. On Sunday, the courses will be from King Harbor to Marina del Rey using existing marks in Santa Monica Bay.

Series Scoring: There are two legs to the race, one leg each day. The corrected finish times for each leg will be added for each boat, and the lowest total time for each class will be the class winner. Second place will be awarded to the boat with the second lowest total corrected time. Other places will be similarly determined.

Trophies: Individual trophies for the series will be awarded at SCCYC about 1800 hours on Sunday. A name plate for the winner of each class will be added to the perpetual trophy.

Parking, Hospitality and Slips in Redondo Beach:

On Saturday: parking is free for RBYC guests after 4:00. Please park where directed.

RBYC bar will open at 4:00. Dinner (details follow) begins at 7:00.

On Sunday AM, hourly parking is probably not free. RBYC's R/C Ginger Clark will host a (free) continental breakfast from 0800 to 0930.

Boats assigned a slip will be asked a \$20 deposit for a dock/head key on arrival. The deposit will be refunded upon return of the key and the identification of the skipper it was assigned to. Keys should be returned to the KHM desk Sunday morning at RBYC between 0900 and 1000 or to RBYC V/C Bruce Neighbors or to RBYC Race/C John Ellinwood, who will be available at SCCYC Sunday after racing.
