

2014 Les Storrs Sailing Instructions

Honoring Les Storrs,
1936 SCCYC Commodore
Saturday, March 22, 2014



1. RULES: The races will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS: Any notice to competitors will be posted by the door of the SCCYC Clubhouse no later than 10:00 hours on the day of the race.
3. SCHEDULE: Three races are planned. The warning signal for the first race shall be at 12:55 hours.
4. CLASSES: Classes and class flags will be posted by the door of the SCCYC Clubhouse not later than 10:00 hours on the day of the race.
5. COURSES: Courses will be selected from the [SCCYC Course Chart #2](http://sccyc.org/racing/sccyc-racing-2014/) available at <http://sccyc.org/racing/sccyc-racing-2014/>. The course distance used for corrected times will be as shown in the course chart.
6. START/FINISH LINE: The **Start** line will be between a orange tetrahedron on the left and a orange flag on the committee boat on the right. The **finish** line is between a flag buoy in the water and a blue flag on the committee boat.
7. STARTING SYSTEM: Rule 26 is changed: The starting signal for one class will be the warning for the next class. Class flags and courses will be signaled no later than the preparatory signal and remain flying until the start of that class.
8. T1 PENALTIES AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT
The first two sentences of rule 44.1 are changed to: 'A boat may take a One-Turn Penalty when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 while *racing*. However, when she may have broken a rule of Part 2 while in the *zone* around a *mark* other than a starting *mark*, her penalty shall be a Two-Turns Penalty'.
9. The PHRF Marine Professional rule does not apply.
10. TIME LIMIT: There is no time limit; the race committee will endeavor to finish racing by 17:00.
11. PROTESTS: Protesting boats are asked to notify the Race Committee at the finish line of their intent to protest. Protests must be filed at SCCYC within one hour of the Race Committee's return to the Clubhouse.
12. SCORING: The Appendix A low-point scoring system will be in effect.
13. CHECK IN: Contestants are requested to check in prior to the first warning signal, and to notify the Race Committee if they leave the course during racing.
14. PRIZES: Commemorative Les Storrs 2014 trophies will be awarded at the SCCYC Clubhouse after racing is completed on Saturday.
15. The Race Committee will monitor channel 68.
