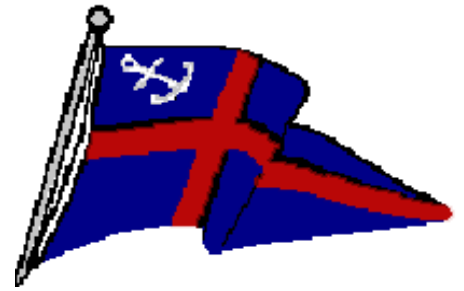


Notice of Race

NOTICE1

Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing. The PHRF Marine Professional rule does not apply.

Eligibility: All keelboats. Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, and racing a boat that is a member of the class or fleet in which it competes. Entrants in the PHRF classes must have a 2013 or 2014 PHRF certificate.

Classes: Classes will be established based upon the number of paid entrants as of 9:00 AM on the day of the race. A minimum of three boats will establish a class. Five boats in a class will get a separate start. One Design Classes are encouraged to have a representative contact Race Chairman, Vincent Paternoster at (818) 620-2043 or racechair@sccyc.org

Entries: Entries must be received by the day of the race before 9:00 AM. The entry fee is as follows:

Under 22 feet \$25

22 to 29 feet \$35

Over 30 feet \$45

Checks should be made payable to SCCYC. Race entries shall be submitted via [regattaNetwork](http://regattaNetwork.com) using the link in the 2014 racing page at <http://sccyc.org>.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC.org no later than 2000 hours on the Friday before the race.

Starting Time & Location: The 1st race will start at **1300 hours**, with the Warning Signal at 1255 hours in the vicinity of "S" mark.

Courses: Courses will be chosen from SCCYC Course chart that will be included with the sailing instructions and will be available for download at <http://www.sccyc.org>. Classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as the weather allows.

Series Scoring: Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, with no throw outs, will be used.

Rule 44 is changed so that if an incident occurs outside the zone for a rounding or finishing mark, then the penalty under rule 44.2 shall be one turn including one tack and one gybe.

Trophies: Commemorative Les Storrs Trophy Glasses will be awarded to all participants at the Awards Ceremony at SCCYC. Top Finishers will receive more than one depending on the number of entrants. Must be present to collect.

Hospitality: As is tradition, racers eat for free, no host bar.
