Notice of Race One Design Weekend July 18-19 Marina del Rey, CA



Rules: This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing.

Eligibility: All One Design Boats, limited to 5 classes at the discretion of the Race Committee. Entrant must be a member of a yacht club or sailing association belonging to SCYA or US Sailing, and a member of the fleet in which it competes.

Classes: Martin 242, OPEN 5.70, Tartan101, J109 (Tartan 101 and J109 may be combined at the request of a majority of the two fleets). We invite other classes to join us. Entries: Entries can be submitted on line at http://www.sccyc.org/racing/2015_racing.htm and must be received by 9 AM, July 18th. The Entry Fees are as follows.

Boats 20 feet or under	\$40
Boats over 20 feet and less than 31	\$60
Boats over 31 feet	\$80
Discount for Entries before Monday July 6th	-\$10

Note: Entry fee includes complimentary informal dinner for all racers

- Saturday July 18
 - Competitors meeting 11:00
 - Racing 13:00 – 18:00
- Sunday July 19
 - Racing 13:00 – 1600

Sailing Instructions: Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC.org no later than 2000 hours on Thursday July 16.

Courses: Courses will be primarily windward/leeward using orange and yellow inflatable marks. The course will be North of the Marina del Rey Spar buoys. There will be 3 or more races for all classes on Saturday and 2 or more races for all classes on Sunday.

Different classes may sail a different number of races, as requested by class representatives, and as the weather allows.

Series Scoring: Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A, with one throw out, if 6 or more races are completed.

Penalties: Rule 44 is changed so that if an incident occurs outside the three-boat-length zone for a rounding or finishing mark, then the penalty under rule 44.2 shall be one turn including one tack and one gibe.

Trophies: Trophies for the Series will be awarded at SCCYC following the last race on Sunday.

Hospitality: Complimentary informal dinner for all racers as well as a no-host bar will be available at the SCCYC Club House following the racing.

Launching: At least one SCCYC Flag Member will be available each day to assist non-members in using the hoist.
