



**Notice of Race**  
**2015**  
**Corinthian Cup**  
**Saturday, May 23, Sunday, May 24**  
**Marina del Rey & King Harbor, CA**

**Rules:** This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). Any sailing Instructions on the mark charts DO NOT APPLY, and only the Corinthian Cup Sailing Instructions apply.

**Classes:** There will be three classes: Cruisers 30 feet and under, Cruisers over 30 feet, and PHRF (all ratings). Class flags will be assigned Saturday morning before 10 AM.

Cruisers will be rated using their ASMBYC Certificated rating for 2015. Cruisers without a rating should complete the free application at: <http://asmbyc-cruising.racingrules.org/>.

**Eligibility:** Club and PHRF memberships are urged but not required. A current PHRF certificate is required for PHRF classes but, not required for entrants in the Cruising classes. The Race Committee reserves the option to assign entries to classes for competitive balance.

**Entries:** Entries should preferably be filled out using the online form and will be accepted no later than 20:00hrs on Friday prior to the race. Later entries must be in writing and presented no later than **10:00 AM on the day of the race**. The entry fee is **\$35** for the two-day, two-leg series, or \$20 for one leg.

Until Friday May 22nd 2000hrs, use the regatta network or at [sccyc.org](http://sccyc.org). When paying by check, make it payable to SCCYC. Race entries can also be deposited in the race entry box (by the stairs to the SCCYC Clubhouse), mailed to SCCYC at 13445 Mindanao Way, Marina del Rey, CA 90292, or presented at RBYC by **10:00 AM on the day of the race**.

**Sailing Instructions:** Sailing Instructions will be available at SCCYC, RBYC and on the SCCYC web site ([www.sccyc.org](http://www.sccyc.org)) no later than **2000 hours on Friday, the day prior to the race**.

**Starting Time & Location:** The race will start at 1300 hours each day, with the Warning Signal at 1255 hours. On Saturday, the start will be out side of the MdR breakwater. On Sunday, the start will be in the ocean out side of the harbor entrance.

**Courses:** On Saturday, the courses will be from Marina del Rey to King Harbor, using existing marks in Santa Monica Bay. On Sunday, the courses will be from King Harbor to Marina del Rey using existing marks in Santa Monica Bay.

**Series Scoring:** There are two legs to the race, one leg each day. The corrected finish times for each leg will be added for each boat, and the lowest total time for each class will establish the class order of finish.

**Trophies:** Individual trophies for the series will be awarded at SCCYC about 1800 hours on Sunday. A name plate for the winner of each class will be added to the perpetual trophy.

**Parking, Hospitality and Slips in Redondo Beach:**

On Saturday: parking is \$3. Mention that you're a guest of RBYC. Please park where directed. RBYC bar will open at 5:00. Dinner begins at 6:30.

Please include the length and beam for your boat. Dock space is usually not assigned until the day before and sometimes not until you arrive in Redondo Beach. Please give Eric as much lead time as possible. Boats assigned a slip will be asked for a \$20 deposit for a dock/head key upon arrival. The deposit will be refunded upon return of the key. Keys should be returned on Sunday morning to RBYC.
