NOTICE OF RACE

1. GENERAL

1.1 The "Wooden Dinghy Race" is a friendly race to bring wooden dinghy sailors together. Many hours went into construction, maintenance, preservation and restoration of these vessels and many of these are of historic value. Safety of crew and the vessels shall be of highest priority when on the race course and in the start and finish area.

2. RULES

- 2.1 This race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 2.2 One design classes will be subject to the rules of their respective class.
- 2.3 Certain rules may be changed, and these changes will be described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.4 Rule 14, Avoiding Contact shall be strictly observed.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The event is open to wooden dinghies. Dinghies are defined as open centerboard or daggerboard, monohulls of 20 feet or less.
- 3.2Three boats of the same design establish a class.
- 3.3To be eligible to compete in the race, competitors must complete and sign an SCCYC Entry Form. Competitors under eighteen years of age must have their entry form signed by a parent or guardian.

4. FEES

4.1 There are no fees but donations to the fleet are encouraged, checks can be made payable to Snipe Fleet 24.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 The Starting Signal will be at 1200 hours for the first race, with three (3) races scheduled. The Race Committee, at its discretion, may run fewer or more races.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions and Course Chart will be available at SCCYC the day of the race, and will be posted at www.sccyc.org prior.

7. VENUE

The race area will be in the main channel, inside of the Marina del Rey Breakwater, from Burton Chace Park to the Marina Breakwater.

8. SCORING

Boats will be scored in the order finished, boats in the same class will be scored in the order finished by class.

9. MEDIA RIGHTS

By participating in this regatta, a competitor (or parent/guardian if under age 18) grants to the OA and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

Prizes will be awarded at SCCYC, as soon as possible after racing.
