



Sailing Instructions 2016 Les Storrs Series

1. **RULES:** The races will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing.
2. **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:** Any notice to competitors will be posted on the outdoor bulletin board on the southwest wall of the SCCYC Clubhouse no later than 0930 hours on the day of the race.
3. **SCHEDULE:** Four races are planned for the PHRF and One Design Fleets. Two races are planned for the Cruising Fleet. The warning signal for the first race shall be at 12 55 hours.
4. **CLASSES:** Classes and class flags are as follows (Subject to Notice to Competitors):

PHRF A	Blue Flag
PHRF B	Pink Flag
M242	Class Flag
Cruising	Green Flag

Other class flags for any other classes will be posted by 0930 hours the day of the race.
5. **COURSES:** Courses for PHRF A, PHRF B and One Design fleets will be selected from the SCCYC Course Chart #2 available for download at Regatta Network. Cruising Fleet courses will be chosen from the SCCYC Random Leg Course Chart #1. Available on Regatta Network.
6. **START/FINISH LINE:** The Start/Finish line will be between a orange tetrahedron on the left and a orange flag on the committee boat on the right.
7. **STARTING SYSTEM:** Rule 26 is changed: The starting signal for one class will be the warning for the next class. Class flags and courses will be signaled no later than the preparatory signal and remain flying until the start of that class.
8. **PENALITES:** Rule 44.2 is changed: If an incident occurs outside the three-boat-length zone for a rounding or finishing mark, then the penalty under rule 44.2 shall be one turn including one tack and one gybe.
9. The PHRF Marine Professional rule does not apply.
10. **TIME LIMIT:** There is no time limit; the race committee will endeavor to finish racing by 4:30.
11. **PROTESTS:** Protesting boats are asked to notify the Race Committee at the finish line of their intent to protest. Protests must be filed at SCCYC within one hour of the Race Committee's return to the Clubhouse.
12. **SCORING:** The Appendix A low-point scoring system will be in effect.
13. **CHECK IN:** Contestants are requested to check in prior to the first warning signal, and to notify the Race Committee if they leave the course during racing.
