



Sailing Instructions

South Coast Corinthian Yacht Club and Lido 14 Fleet 2 Present
The Lido 14 Fleet 8th Annual Single-Handed Championship
Saturday, October 7, 2017



Rules: This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, and the current Lido 14 Class Rules with the following exceptions:

1. There shall only be one person racing in the sloop.
2. The total minimum weight of the skipper and ballast shall be 180 pounds.
3. It shall be permissible to use any device to hold the tiller in place while the skipper is setting or recovering the whisker pole.

Schedule of Races: Five Races are scheduled. One will constitute a series.

Racing Area: Racing will be inside the Marina del Rey harbor between the "No Sail" lanes of the outer entrance channel.

Courses: Courses will be selected from the "2017 Dinghy Course Chart". Charts will be available the day of the regatta and at <http://sccyc.org/>. The selected course for each race will be indicated by a pennant flown during the start sequence.

Marks: Marks will be flags, inflatable cylinders or hippity-hops. Mark positions are approximate and may be adjusted by the RC. All marks designated as part of the course shall be left to port unless specified on the course chart.

Obstructions: The "No Sail" buoys designate the lane for powering in and out of the harbor on each side of the entrance channel. The line between these buoys is a continuing obstruction. The penalty for crossing the obstruction described above shall be a **Two-Turns Penalty** that complies with RRS 44.2.

The Start

1. The first race will start at 1300 hours.
2. The Start Line will be between "S" mark and an orange flag on the committee boat.
3. Appendix S "Sound Signal Starting System" will be used. (This is a rolling 3-minute start.)

The Finish: The Finish Line will be between "S" mark and an orange flag on the committee boat.

Penalty System: Rule 44.2 is changed: If an incident occurs outside the zone of a rounding or finishing mark, rule 44.2 is changed so that the **Two-Turns Penalty** is replaced by a **One-Turn Penalty**.

Protests: Competitors wishing to file a protest shall notify the Race Committee of their intent to file as soon as possible. Forms must be filed within one hour of the RC's return to the SCCYC Clubhouse.

Scoring. The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, shall apply except that there shall be no throw-outs. This changes RRS A2.1.
