GENERAL INFORMATION

1. RULES

- 1.1 This series shall be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 One design classes will be subject to the rules of their respective class.
- 1.3 RRS V1 (one turn penalty for incidents outside the zone of a non-starting mark) will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The event is open to dinghies between 12 and 18 feet in length. Dinghies are defined as open centerboard, daggerboard, or leeboard boats.
- 2.2 Three boats of the same design establish a class.
- 2.3 To be eligible to compete in the race, competitors must complete and sign an SCCYC Entry Form. Competitors under eighteen years of age must have their entry form signed by a parent or guardian.

3. FEES

- 3.1 Entry fee for each day of racing will be \$15.
- 3.2 Series entry fee will be \$35.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 There will be a mandatory skipper's meeting at SCCYC at 1000 on each race day.
- 4.2 Two races are scheduled for each event. The Starting Signal will be at 1300 hours for the first race.
- 4.3 The Race Committee (RC), at its discretion, may run fewer or more races.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions and Course Chart will be available online the day before the race and at SCCYC.
- 5.2 Notice to competitors will be posted no later than 1100 race day on the exterior wall next to the entrance to the club, near the mail box.



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6. SCHEDULE

Two races are scheduled for each day according to the following schedule:

#2	Saturday, July 1	1000	1300
#3	Saturday, November 4	1000	1300

7. VENUE

The race area will be in the main channel, inside of the Marina del Rey Breakwater, from Burton Chace Park to the Marina Breakwater. An optional course may include a portion outside the MDR Breakwater.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 Boats will be rated using basic Portsmouth number (D-PN) listed by US Sailing and PHRF Time on Distance formula for scoring.
- 8.2 Series shall be scored as provided in RRS Appendix A for series scoring.
- 8.3 There will be no discards. All races will count.

9. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at SCCYC, as soon as possible after racing.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Radios are not required but encouraged. Race Committee (RC) will monitor channel 68.

11. DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

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FURTHER INFORMATION

Docking: is available at the dinghy dock at Fisherman's Village for up to four hours. Boats must be docked on the inside of the dock and the sea wall. Please contact the Event Chair or SCCYC Race Chair for info.

Launching: Boats may be trailer-launched at the public launch ramp located at 13477 Fiji Way (Basin H) for a fee. The entrance is one and a half blocks West of Lincoln Blvd. For more info please call MPI at 310-821-1081. SCCYC no longer has access to a hoist.

Parking: Parking at SCCYC is within the Fisherman's Village Parking lot and will be validated for up to two hours. Please be sure to have your parking ticket validated!
