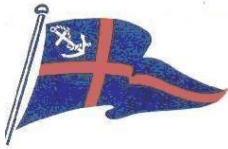




Sailing Instructions

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing.

SKIPPER'S MEETING: 0900-1030 at PMYC (optional)

NOTICES TO COMPETITORS: Notices will be made via Hail on the course by the Race Committee.

SCHEDULE OF RACES: Six (6) races are scheduled. The Race committee may elect to run fewer races. The first race will start at 1400 hours. Subsequent races will be started as soon as is practical.

RACING AREA: Racing will be inside the Marina del Rey harbor between the "No Sail" lanes of the outer entrance channel.

CHECK IN: Not Required.

COURSES: Courses will be selected from the 2018 Dinghy Course Chart. Charts will be available the day of the regatta and at <http://sccyc.org/>. The selected course for each race will be indicated by a pennant flown during the start. The course may change for each fleet.

MARKS: Marks will be flags, inflatable cylinders or hippity-hops. Mark positions are approximate and may be adjusted by the RC. All marks designated as part of the course shall be left to port unless specified on the course chart.

OBSTRUCTIONS: The "No Sail" buoys designate the lane for powering in and out of the harbor on each side of the entrance channel. The line between these buoys is a continuing obstruction. The penalty for crossing the obstruction described above shall be a **Two-Turns Penalty** that complies with RRS 44.2

PENALITIES: Appendix T Section A is in force. Except as provided under **OBSTRUCTIONS** above, Rule 44.2 is changed: If an incident occurs outside the zone of a rounding or finishing mark, rule 44.2 is changed so that the **Two-Turns Penalty** is replaced by a **One-Turn Penalty**.

Other Class Flags to be determined at the skippers meeting or communicated on the water by the RC

START: The Start Line will be between "S" mark and an orange flag on the committee boat.

ORDER OF STARTS: The RC will determine the order of starts on the water and may change the order at its discretion. Boats not in sequence shall keep clear.

STARTING SYSTEM: Appendix S "Sound Signal Starting System" will be used. The **Start Signal** for each class will serve as the **Warning Signal** for the next class. (This is a rolling 3-minute start.)

FINISH: The Finish Line will be between "S" mark and an orange flag on the committee boat.

PROTESTS: Competitors wishing to file a protest shall notify the Race Committee of their intent to file as soon as possible. Forms must be filed within one hour of the RC's return to the Club. Appendix T Section C "Expedited Hearings" is in force.

SCORING: The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A, shall apply. If six (6) races are completed a competitor's worst result will be thrown out. This modifies section A2 of Appendix A. One completed race constitutes a regatta.
