1. RULES

- 1.1 This series shall be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 One design classes will be subject to the rules of their respective class.
- 1.3 RRS V1 (one turn penalty for incidents outside the zone of a non-starting mark) will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The event is open to dinghies between 12 and 18 feet in length. Dinghies are defined as open centerboard, dagger board, or leeboard boats.
- 2.2 To be eligible to compete in the race, competitors must register at regattanetwork <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20870> . Competitors under eighteen years of age must have their entry form signed by a parent or guardian.

3. FEES

- 3.1 Entry fee for each day of racing will be \$20.
- 3.2 Series entry fee will be \$30 (2 days).

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 There will be a skipper's meeting at SCCYC at 1100 on each race day. This is not mandatory but is recommended.
- 4.2 Three races are scheduled for each event. The Race Committee (RC), may run fewer or more races.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1 The Sailing Instructions and Course Chart will be available online the day before the race at www.sccyc.org.

6. SCHEDULE

Three days of racing are scheduled according to the following schedule:

7. VENUE

The race area will be in the main channel, inside of the Marina del Rey Breakwater, from Burton Chace Park to the Marina Breakwater.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 Boats will be rated using basic Portsmouth number (D-PN) listed by US Sailing and PHRF Time on Time formula for scoring.
- 8.2 Series shall be scored as provided in RRS Appendix A for series scoring.
- 8.3 There will be no discards. All races will count.

9. PRIZES

No Prizes due to COVID-19 guidance. ~~Prizes will be awarded at SCCYC, as soon as possible after racing. Snacks will be offered.~~

10. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Radios are not required but encouraged. Race Committee (RC) will monitor channel 68.

11. DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

FURTHER INFORMATION

Docking: is available at the dinghy dock at Fisherman's Village for up to four hours. Boats must be docked on the inside of the dock and the sea wall. Please contact the Event Chair or SCCYC Race Chair for info.

Launching: Boats may be trailer-launched at the public launch ramp located at 13477 Fiji Way (Basin H). Enter the lot from Fiji Way, one block west of Lincoln Boulevard. SCCYC does not have access to a hoist at the moment.

Launch ramp:

The pay station, at the entrance, accepts \$1 and \$5 bills, coins, and credit cards (Visa and Mastercard). No change is given. The fee includes launching, recovery, and 24-hour parking.

*Vehicles with trailers – \$13 *Vehicles only –\$10

Trailer must be attached to a tow vehicle at all times. Vehicle must display parking receipt front-side-up and visible on the driver's side dash board of the vehicle for each day parked, one receipt for each 24 hour period, up to a maximum of 7 days within a 30-day period.
